#### **ABOUT CROCHET TERMS:**

*I've followed the USA terminology.*

*Stitch: st*

*Chain: ch*

*Single Crochet: sc*

#### **ABOUT YARN:**

*One skein: Avelita (Schachenmayr): 44 yards (40 meters), 50 grams (1.76 ounces).*

*We need 4 skeins for this project and two buttons.*

#### **ABOUT CROCHET HOOK:**

*Tunisian 15mm.*

#### **ABOUT THE PATTERN:**

*Chain 18.*

*Row 1: Basic Forward and Return (see:*

*Row 2:*

*Forward pass: TeS in each st of row 1.*

*Return: normal return row.*

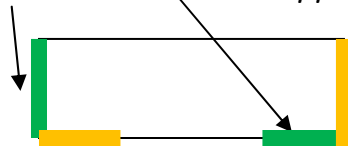
*Row 3 and onwards: forward pass: TES in each st of previous row*

*Return: normal return row.*

*How many rows?*

*As many as you like... (see photos).*

*Weave ends and sew this side to the opposite long border*



*Do the same for the other side! And sew the buttons as shown in the photos.*
