



Cowl of Many Colors

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Difficulty Level: Beginner

Size: One Size fits all. Finished Cowl circumference is 30 inches with a depth of 10 to 12 inches.

Gauge: 7 stitches and 3 rows = 4 inches

Supplies Needed:

- Size N (10.00mm) crochet hook
- 2 skeins Darn Good Yarn silk or chiffon of your choice (between 100 and 120 yards for both)
- 2 skeins super bulky acrylic yarn of your choice in any color (approximately 130 yards for both)
- Scissors
- Tapestry Needle (for sewing in your ends)

Stitches Used:

- ch (chain)
- sl st (slip stitch)
- dc (double crochet)
- sc (single crochet)
- blo (back loop only)

Notes:

- The entirety of the cowl will be worked by holding two strands together. One strand of the ribbon and one strand of the super bulky acrylic.

Directions:

Holding two strands together, make a slip knot and chain 51. Being careful not to twist, join with sl st in beginning ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 2, dc in same ch as joining and in each ch around; join with sl st in first dc - 50 dc.

Rnd 2: Ch 2, dc **IN BLO** in the same ch as joining and in each ch around; join with a sl st in first dc – 50 dc.

Rnd 3 – 8(10): Repeat rnd 2.

~You should have a cowl roughly 10 inches deep. You can choose to finish off at this point or continue for a further 2 rows to create an extra deep cowl of 12 inches.~

Rnd 9 (11): ch 1, sc in same ch as joining and in each ch around.

Finish off: sl st into the top of ch 2 and pull through. Use tapestry needle to weave in ends.
